NZB National/Regional Conference

- Need to know confirmed date well ahead of time
- No return Dunedin/Wellington flights available to cover Conference timing
- OSRC forced to incur cost of 1 night's accommodation
- Less flights available on a Sunday
- *** **Motion**: That NZB be requested to fund 1 delegate (flights, & accommodation if required) for National Conferences Maria/Marilyn

Clubs Requiring Assistance

Agreed that Balclutha & Milton may benefit most from RBM assistance Jane Stearn advised that Te Anau & Taieri would welcome RBM visits

National 15A – Otago Club, tomorrow

Concerns:

- that the minimal profit will be totally usurped with payment of MasterPoints
- that NZB controls some fixed expenses despite entry numbers
- initially told full Barometer event, then changed to Half Barometer
- boards had already been dealt for Full Barometer incurring extra cost
- OSRC required to cover Director's transport to/from Dunedin Airport
- some players believe the entry fee of \$80.00 is too high

Hence, OSRC incurs another loss Likely reasons for lack of external entries: Cost of Travel; + loss of NZ Trialing at National Tournaments

2020 South Island Pairs – 10A

- Invercargill Club = currently proposed host
- Concerns re location & lack of profit
- Local or external player support is not assured
- Cost & frequency of flights into/out of Invercargill
- No National Selection from this event hence no necessity to attend
- Do we know that the Invercargill Club is supportive of hosting this event
- Would require extensive local sponsorship
- Local players don't understand the necessity for higher entry fees

Losses for this event held in Invercargill are guaranteed OSRC does not wish to be liable for losses incurred
